## YARN

### Colourscape

## NEEDLES

1 pair 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles  
 1 pair 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles  
 cable needle  
 stitch holder

## TENSION

14 sts and 18 rows to 10cm measured over st st using 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**C4F** – slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and leave at front of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

**C4B** – slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and leave at back of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

## BACK

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 67 [73: 83: 91: 101] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** \* K1, P1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**Row 2:** P1, \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form 1x1 rib. \*\*

Work 2 rows more in rib, ending with RS facing for next row and dec 1 st at end of last row. 66 [72: 82: 90: 100]sts.

Change to 7mm (US 10½) needles.

Begin with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont until back

meas 46 [47: 47: 48: 49]cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

### Shape armholes

Inc 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 72 [78: 88: 96: 106] sts.

**Next row (RS):** Cast on 6 sts, K1, (K1, P1) twice, K to end, 78 [84: 94: 102: 112] sts.

**Next row:** Cast on 6 sts, K1, (P1, K1) twice, P to last 5 sts, (K1, P1) twice, K1. 84 [90: 100: 108: 118] sts.

**Next row (RS):** K1, (K1, P1) twice, K to last 5 sts, (P1, K1) twice, K1.

**Next row:** K1, (P1, K1) twice, P to last 5 sts, (K1, P1) twice, K1.

The last 2 rows set g st edge st, with 4 sts in rib. Cont as set until armhole meas 25 [26: 27: 28: 29] cm, from beg of shaping ending with RS facing for next row.

### Shape shoulders and back neck

**Next row (RS):** Cast off 9 [10: 8: 9: 10] sts, K until there are 26 [28: 36: 39: 42] sts on right needle, turn and leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.

**Next row (WS):** Cast off 4 [4: 3: 3: 3] sts at beg of next row, then 1 [1: 2: 2: 2] foll alt rows **and at same time** cast off 9 [10: 9: 10: 11] sts at beg of 2<sup>nd</sup> row, then 0 [0: 1: 1: 1] foll alt rows.

Cast off rem 9 [10: 9: 10: 11] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 14 [14: 12: 12: 14] sts, and K to end.

Complete to match first side reversing all shapings.

## FRONT

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 67 [73: 83: 91: 101] sts.

Work as given for back to \*\*.

Work 1 row more in rib, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

**Next row (WS):** Rib 29 [32: 37: 41: 46], (m1, rib 2) twice, inc in next st, (rib 2, m1), twice, rib to end. 72 [78: 88: 96: 106] sts.

Change to 7mm (US 10½) needles and cont as folls:-

**Row 1 (RS):** K26 [29: 34: 38: 43], P2, K4, C4B, C4F, K4, P2, K26 [29: 34: 38: 43].

**Row 2 (WS):** P26 [29: 34: 38: 43], K2, P16, K2, P26 [29: 34: 38: 43].

**Row 3:** K26 [29: 34: 38: 43], P2, K2, C4B, K4, C4F, K2, P2, K26 [29: 34: 38: 43].

**Row 4:** As row 2.

**Row 5:** K26 [29: 34: 38: 43], P2, C4B, K8, C4F, P2, K26 [29: 34: 38: 43].

**Row 6:** As row 2.

These 6 rows set cable panel.

Cont without shaping until front matches back to start of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape armholes

Inc 1 st as set at each end of next 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 78 [84: 94: 102: 112] sts.

**Next row (RS):** Cast on 6sts, K1, (K1, P1) twice, patt to end, 84 [90: 100: 108: 118] sts.

**Next row:** Cast on 6sts, K1, (P1, K1) twice, patt to last 6sts, (K1, P1) twice, K1. 90 [96: 106: 114: 124] sts.

**Next row (RS):** K1, (K1, P1) twice, patt to last 5sts, (P1, K1) twice, K1.

**Next row:** K1, (P1, K1) twice, patt to last 5sts, (K1, P1) twice, K1.

The last 2 rows set g st edge st, with 4sts in rib.

Cont straight until 14 [14: 16: 16: 18] rows less have been worked than on back to start of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape front neck

**Next row:** Patt 35 [38: 44: 48: 52], turn and leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge in next 5 [5: 5: 5: 3] rows, then on 3 [3: 4: 4: 6] foll alt rows, then foll 4<sup>th</sup> row. 27 [30: 35: 39: 43] sts.

Work 1 [1: 3: 3: 5] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. (Armhole should now match back to start of shoulder shaping).

#### Shape shoulders

Cast off 9 [10: 8: 9: 10] sts at beg of next row, then foll 1 [1: 0: 0: 0] alt rows, then – [–: 9: 10: 11] sts at beg of next row, then foll 0 [0: 1: 1: 1] foll alt rows.

Cast off rem 9 [10: 9: 10: 11] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 20 [20: 18: 18: 20] st, dec 6sts evenly at same time, patt to end.

Complete to match first side reversing all shapings.

#### MAKING UP

Press. Join right shoulder seam, using back stitch or mattress stitch if preferred.

#### Neckband

With RS facing and using 6mm (US 10) needles, pick up and knit 14 [14: 16: 16: 17] sts down left side of neck, 16 [16: 16: 16: 18] sts from front neck, 14 [14: 16: 16: 17] sts up right side of neck, 9 [9: 11: 11: 11] sts down side of back neck, 14 [14: 12: 12: 14] sts from back neck and 8 [8: 10: 10: 10] sts up side of back neck. 75 [75: 81: 81: 87] sts.

**Next row (WS of garment RS of collar):** starting with a K row cont in st st until collar measures 14.5cm ending with RS facing for next row.

Now work 4 rows in rib as set for back.

Cast off in rib.
